



Exterior Transponder Mounting Guidelines

Who Needs This?

- Trucks, buses, coaches, RVs, and other classes of large commercial vehicles.

Before You Start

- Use the mounting location the device was programmed for.
- Ensure a clear line of sight to toll antennas.

Maintain

- Minimum of 24" clearance forward if the bumper/body protrudes
- Minimum of 15" from the roadway
- Within 4" from vehicle centerline

Mounting Options

For proper operation, make sure the transponder is mounted as follows:

- Front License Plate
 1. Remove the 2 upper license plate mounting screws that secure the license plate to the front of the vehicle.
 2. Using those screws, secure the transponder - with arrows pointing upward - to the front of the vehicle.
